A graduate of the School of Medicine of Science Tokyo's predecessor TMDU, Dr. Kitano was a member of the first cohort of the Health Science Leadership Program (HSLP).

During her time in the HSLP, she represented Japan at the St. Gallen Symposium in Switzerland and the G20 Youth Summit in Argentina. After graduating in 2019, she completed her initial clinical training at the University of Tokyo Hospital. She moved to Australia in 2022, where she continues to build a successful career. Alongside her clinical work, Dr. Kitano also serves as an International Medical Graduate (IMG) Officer at Monash Health, engaging in medical education and advocacy on behalf of other IMGs.
