He is currently a Professor at the University of Miami and visiting professor/adjunct professor at universities in England, Japan and the U.S., and Medical Director of a clinical transplant testing laboratory. - The differences in research environments in Japan and in foreign countries
- Important points of successful international collaboration
- Difficulties faced working in an overseas laboratory and how he overcame them
