In the eighth FYRM session of academic year 2016 we will be hosting Dr. Noriyuki Kasahara, a 1986 TMDU School of Medicine and 1993 Doctorate in Endocrinology alumnus. After graduation, he went on to obtain a Ph.D. in Endocrinology from the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). He has conducted research at many well-known U.S. universities including UCSF, University of Southern California, and University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA). He is currently a Professor at the University of Miami and visiting professor/adjunct professor at universities in England, Japan and the U.S., and Medical Director of a clinical transplant testing laboratory. This session will be carried out in a round-table discussion format, and will cover the following points. Everyone is welcome to join us in a hearty discussion.

- The trigger that led him to choose a global career
- The differences in research environments in Japan and in foreign countries
- Important points of successful international collaboration
- Difficulties faced working in an overseas laboratory and how he overcame them
