- Open to all students, residents, post-docs, and faculty

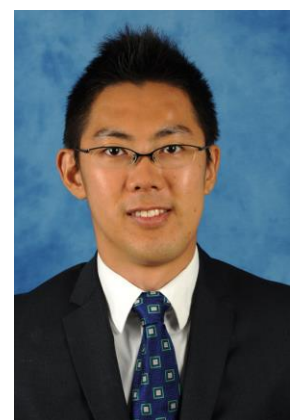
