For the first FYRM session of the academic year 2019, we will host Dr. Kanna Sugiura, a psychiatrist. After she graduated from Tokyo Women’s Medical University in 2003, Dr. Sugiura trained as a resident with a focus on psychiatry at Yokohama City University. In 2010, she earned a master’s degree from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine and then worked at Fiji National University, the WHO, and a national hospital in Equatorial Guinea. After returning to Japan, Dr. Sugiura joined at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as an administrative official. Dr. Sugiura remains active in the front lines of clinical medicine as a psychiatrist and occupational health physician. In addition, since 2016, Dr. Sugiura has been conducting a study about decision-making in the mental health field for her PhD at the University of Tokyo.
