Since 2007, he has been working for many years as a senior advisor at the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), contributing to activities in the field of international cooperation. His main areas of expertise are development assistance in the field of health and medical care, infectious disease control, and public health in general. He has worked in approximately 40 countries, mainly focusing on infectious diseases and clinical medicine, including project formulation and evaluation, especially as a project leader for tuberculosis control in Afghanistan, where he has been engaged in field activities for approximately 15 years.
